



Four Years of Impact

The Food Bank, Ministerial Alliance, and Leoti Foods collaborated, using Pathways funding to increase access to healthy foods for those who are in need. Together, they created fruit and vegetables vouchers for the food bank that community members can redeem at the grocery store for healthier food options for their families.

The Wichita County Fair Board, in collaboration with the county utilized a Pathways grant to add the Pavilion to the fairgrounds, creating a smokefree, accessible gathering place for the community. The project served as a catalyst for further development and enhancement of the fairground. Since its addition, the fair board has enhanced outdoor facilities, including renovating the livestock barn and planning further improvements to surrounding buildings.

There is more exciting Pathways work to come! Keep an eye out for improved sidewalks and crossings to make sure kids in our community can safely walk or ride a bike to school.
